

Academic Year 2021/22: Academic Term 1 Nov-Jan (Holiday timetable)

With overseas travel restricted and outdoor activities minimised, many students may be home with little supervision and few activities to engage them during the school holidays. The Edu Experience will operate on a special modified timetable in Academic Term 1 (Holiday timetable) of Academic Year 2021/2022.

Holiday timetable:	20 November 2021 to 31 December 2021
Academic timetable:	1 November 2021 to 19 November 2021

To support our students' learning, we have designed a holiday timetable to engage students from 9.30 am to 7.30 pm on weekdays and until 3.30 pm on Saturdays.

FAQ:

1. Why does The Edu Experience have two timetables for the school holidays and school term?

The **Holiday** timetable is designed for our children to rest and recharge, while giving them an early start on next year's learning.

During the school holidays, our timetable includes lessons in the morning and afternoon so that students can be meaningfully engaged throughout the entire day.

In January, when the school term starts, the timetable will revert to our **Academic** timetable.

2. How are the two timetables different?

(Holiday timetable) The Holiday timetable will run from 9.30 am to 7.30 pm on weekdays and until 3.30 pm on Saturdays.

All lessons on the **Holiday** timetable will be 3 hours long so that students can engage in more activities. A typical lesson will consist of approximately 1.5 to 2 hours of curriculum teaching and 1 to 1.5 hours of study group or enrichment programmes.

(Academic timetable) The Academic timetable will run from 2 pm to 7.30 pm on weekdays and 9.30 am to 6 pm on weekends (Saturday and Sunday).

3. Are the fees the same in November and December?

Our fees are the same throughout the year. Our extended operating hours are provided at no extra charge to support our learners.



4. Will my child still get unlimited hours? How do I book extra lessons?

Yes, your child will still be able to book extra lessons if he or she needs more guidance. For students who would like a conducive environment to revise and self-study, our study group lessons (with teacher supervision) will still be available.

You may book extra lessons through the phone, email or through our on-boarding team upon sign-up.

5. Are there still study groups and enrichment programmes?

Yes, our study group lessons will be available throughout the entire day for both **Holiday** and **Academic** timetables.

Our enrichment programmes will be available for both **Holiday** and **Academic** timetables as well.

6. How do I choose my preferred lesson slot in the Holiday timetable?

Upon sign-up with us, you will choose one preferred lesson slot for the **Holiday** timetable and one preferred lesson slot for the **Academic** timetable.

7. Are the lessons online or physical?

All our lessons are conducted physically in our centre at Tampines.

In case of government-mandated stoppage of in-person lessons, all classes will continue to run as online sessions.

Study groups and enrichment programmes will only be available as physical classes.

The above applies to both our **Holiday** timetable and **Academic** timetable.
